
Biocuration Virtual Issue 2013: Submission Deadline November 30, 2012

The 2013 Biocuration Virtual issue of the Journal DATABASE will be published online in conjunction with the Biocuration 2013 meeting, and the International Society for Biocuration. The 6th International Biocuration Conference will be held in Cambridge, UK on 7-10th April 2013. Manuscript submissions for the Biocuration 2013 Virtual Issue are due **November 30, 2013**. To submit a manuscript, go to the DATABASE journal's home page (http://database.oxfordjournals.org/), read the "Instructions to Authors", and click on "Submit now". Authors should state CLEARLY that they are submitting a manuscript for consideration for the Biocuration 2013 meeting's issue, so that the DATABASE staff will ensure appropriate fast-tracking. In addition, select "Biocuration Conference Paper" as the manuscript type on the DATABASE submission form.

Submitting a paper to DATABASE does not sign you up to give a talk or poster, so you must register your interest separately. If you wish to present at the meeting, please submit an abstract on the conference's website. Abstracts are due on January 31, 2013.

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BioCreative IV Challenge & Workshop

Call For Participation

BioCreative: Critical Assessment of Information Extraction in Biology

(http://www.biocreative.org/) is a community-wide effort for evaluating text mining and information extraction systems applied to the biological domain. Building on the success of the previous BioCreative Challenge Evaluations and Workshops (BioCreative I, II, II.5, III, and 2012 workshop) [1-5], the BioCreative Organizing Committee will host the BioCreative IV Challenge (http://www.biocreative.org/events/ biocreative-iv/CFP/) at NCBI, National Institutes of Health, Bethesda, Maryland, on October 7-9, 2013. One key goal of BioCreative is the active involvement of the text mining user community in the design of the tracks, preparation of corpus and the testing of interactive systems. For BioCreative IV, the selection of the tracks has been driven in part by suggestions from the biocuration community during the BioCreative workshop 2012, and by our goal of addressing a major barrier on system usage/adoption: **interoperability**.

This time BioCreative IV will consist of **five tracks**:

1. Interoperability (BioC) – Development of an interoperable BioNLP module that can be seamlessly coupled to BioC compliant modules

2. Chemical and Drug Named Entity Recognition (CHEMDNER) – Detection of mentions of chemical compounds and drugs, in particular those chemical entity mentions that can subsequently be linked to a chemical structure

3. Comparative Toxicogenomics Database (CTD) Curation – Provision of Web Services to identify gene, chemical, disease, and action term mentions supporting CTD curation in PubMed abstracts

4. Gene Ontology (GO) curation – Development of modules to aid GO curators in identifying articles with

curatable GO information (triage) and extracting gene function terms and the associated evidence sentences in fulllength articles

5. Interactive Curation (IAT) – Demonstration and evaluation of web-based systems addressing user-defined tasks, evaluated by curators on performance and usability.

REGISTRATION: Teams can participate in one or more of these tracks. Team registration will start on November 19, 2012 and will continue until final commitment is requested by the individual tracks. To register a team, visit http://www.biocreative.org/news/biocreative-iv/team/
